

CABE 2025 BILINGUAL TEACHERSHIP AWARD

CABE encourages members who are enrolled in a college or university and have declared a major leading to a California bilingual teaching credential/authorization to apply for a CABE Bilingual Teachership Award. The CABE 2025 Bilingual Teachership Award is an endowment fund established by CABE to award \$2,000 to college and university students seeking a teaching career and pursuing a bilingual teaching credential/authorization. CABE chapter leaders, regional representatives, and individual members may nominate college and university students for the Bilingual Teachership Awards.

Eligibility Criteria - All Candidates Must

- Be a CABE member
- Be a resident of California
- Be enrolled in a college/university with a declared major leading to a bilingual teaching credential/authorization (BILA, elementary/secondary) and be currently enrolled full-time (minimum of 12 units)

Required Documents

- An online teachership application must be submitted by *Friday, December 6, 2024, at 11:59 PM (Pacific Time)*.
- A letter of recommendation from a current professional reference such as a professor, program coordinator, or current supervisor
- A nomination letter from a CABE chapter leader, regional representative, or other active CABE member
- A copy of college/university transcript (unofficial copy is acceptable)
- A head-and-shoulder high resolution photo

The recipient will receive their award during the Educator and Parent Award Luncheon on *Thursday, March 27, 2025*, at the Long Beach Convention Center, 300 East Ocean Blvd., Long Beach, CA 90802. An official notification letter will include the exact time of arrival and additional details.

Awardees will be notified on Thursday, January 9, 2025.
